Under section the *Freedom of Information Act*, 1982, the public has a right to seek access to "documents" rather than to discrete bits of information. However, section 17 of the FOI Act enables **nbn** to provide applicants with information where such information is not available in a discrete written form, but it is "ordinarily available to the agency for retrieving or collating stored information". In that regard, a document containing the Relevant Prior Work Information could be prepared.
