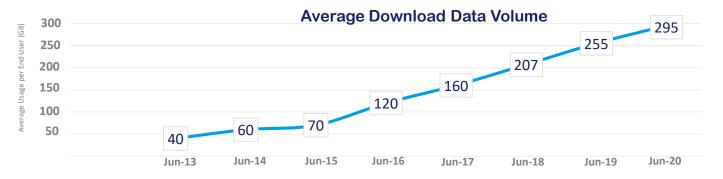


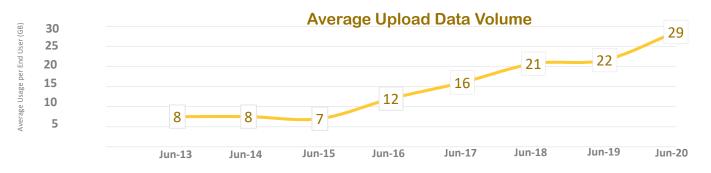
#### Activation of premises

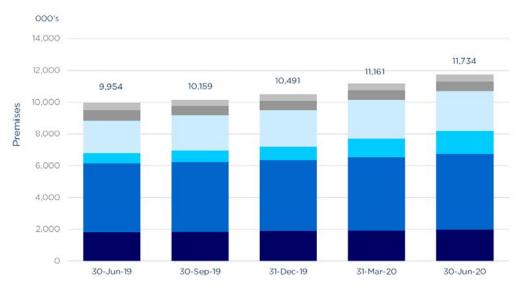

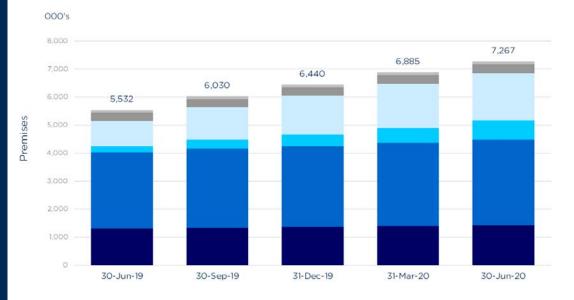

<sup>1</sup> During the twelve months ended 30 June 2020, NBN Co declared 1,910,000 new premises ready to connect. However, following the completion of a full analysis of available premises data for Satellite and Fixed Wireless areas, the number of premises within these areas has been reduced by approximately 130,000. This reduction has been applied to the reported premises ready to connect figure as at 30 September 2019, 31 December 2019, 31 March 2020 and 30 June 2020.



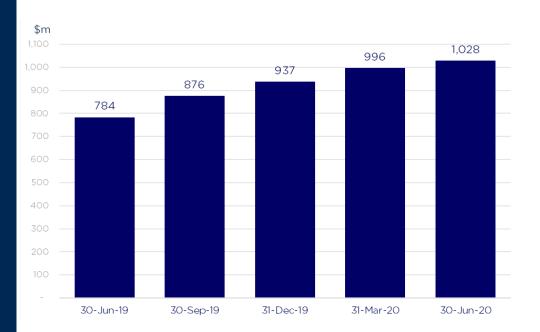

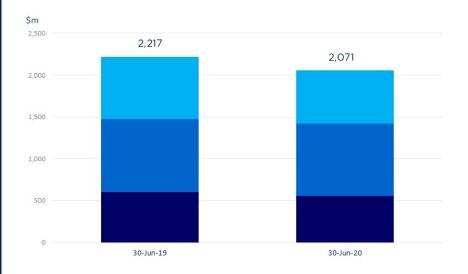

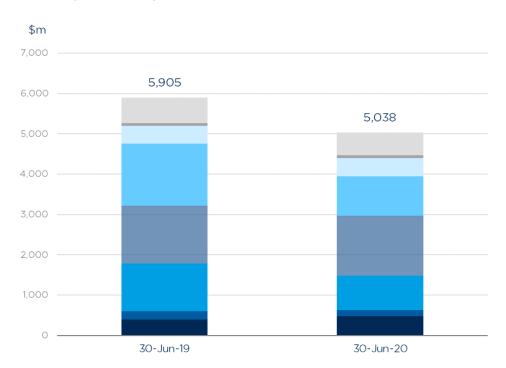

1 Following the adoption of AASB 16 Leases from 1 July 2019, certain operating lease and right-of-use arrangements are no longer accounted for as operating expenses but instead are recognised on the balance sheet as a right-of-use asset and lease liability with associated depreciation and interest expenses recorded in the income statement. The impact of these accounting requirements has resulted in lower operating expenses of approximately \$190 million in comparison to the corresponding prior period. This reduction in operating expenses is offset by increased depreciation and amortisation and interest expense in the period.



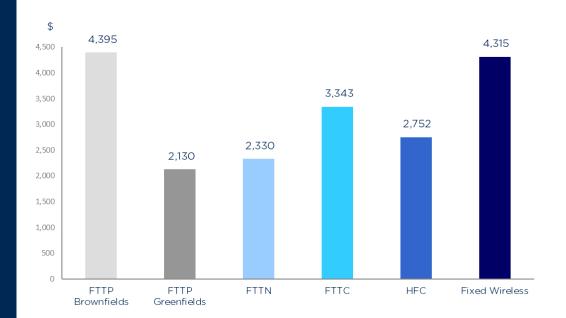

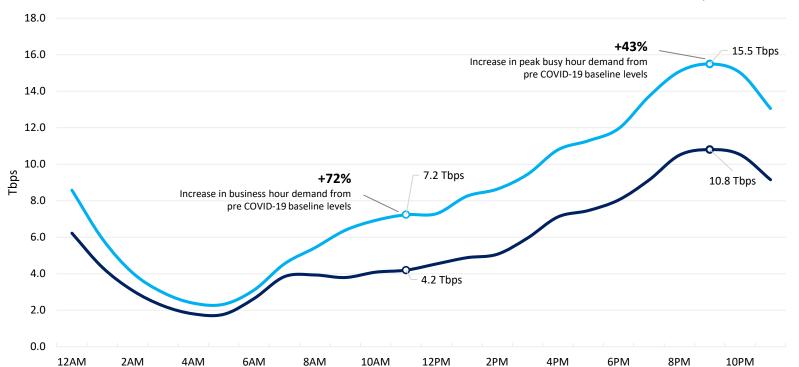
