nbn FibreOne Customer Trial Agreement ('Trial Agreement')

The Trial Agreement has been developed for the limited purpose of facilitating testing and trial activities in connection with nbn's proposed launch of the nbn FibreOne solution.

Accordingly, the terms of the Test Agreement are intended to apply solely to the testing arrangements during the trial period and should not be taken as final or enduring commercial terms for the FibreOne product.

nbn is currently progressing development of the proposed **FibreOne Standard Form of Access Agreement (SFAA)**, which will govern the ongoing supply of FibreOne services following completion of the trial.

Please note:

- The Test Agreement does not represent the final form of the FibreOne contractual framework; and
- Participating MSPs will be provided with an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed SFAA as part of an upcoming formal industry consultation process.
- This consultation will be conducted in accordance with nbn's established industry engagement processes, and we strongly encourage your participation to help inform the final form of the SFAA.
- Further information on the consultation process, including timing and supporting materials, will be provided.
