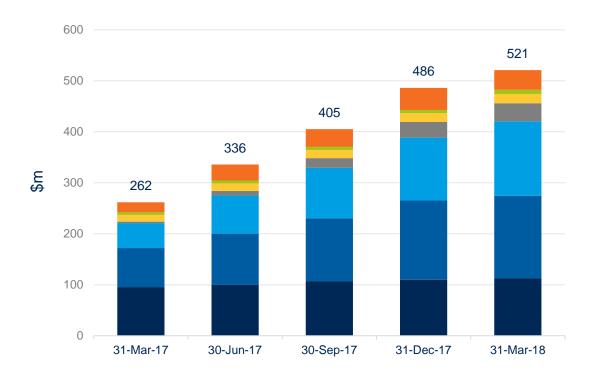

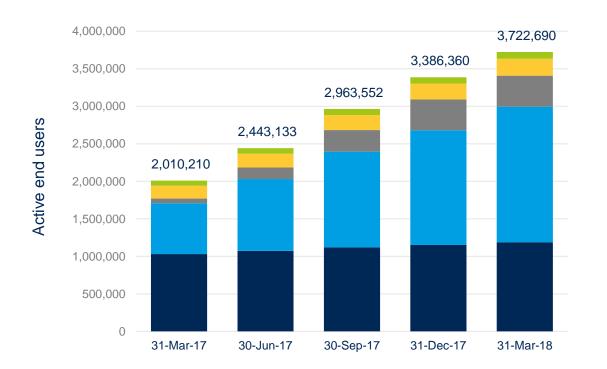

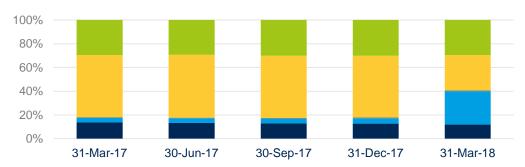

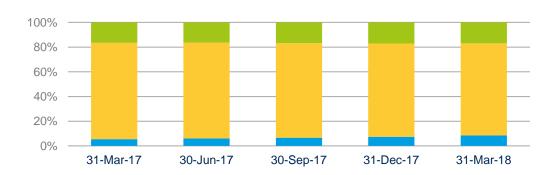

#### Fixed Wireless wholesale speed tiers

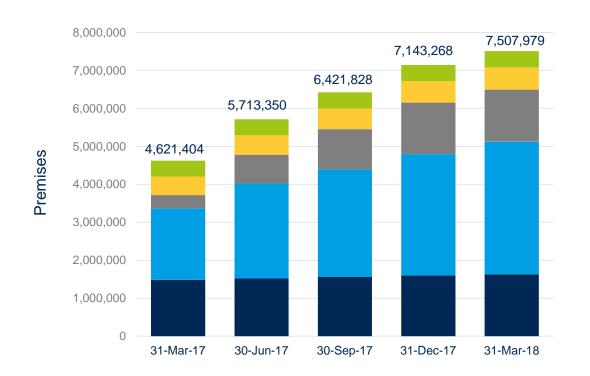

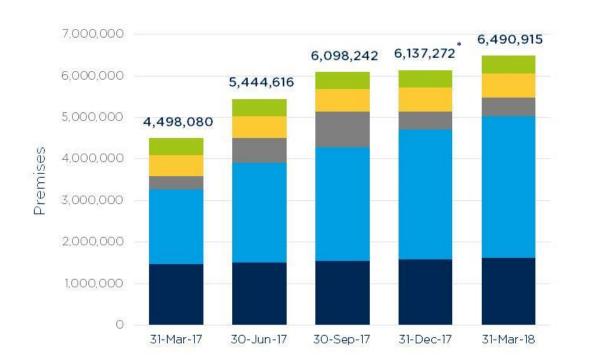

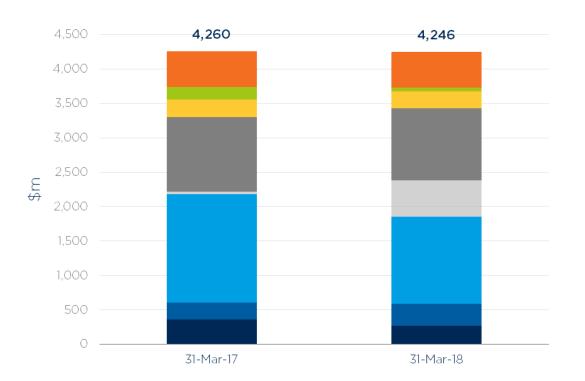

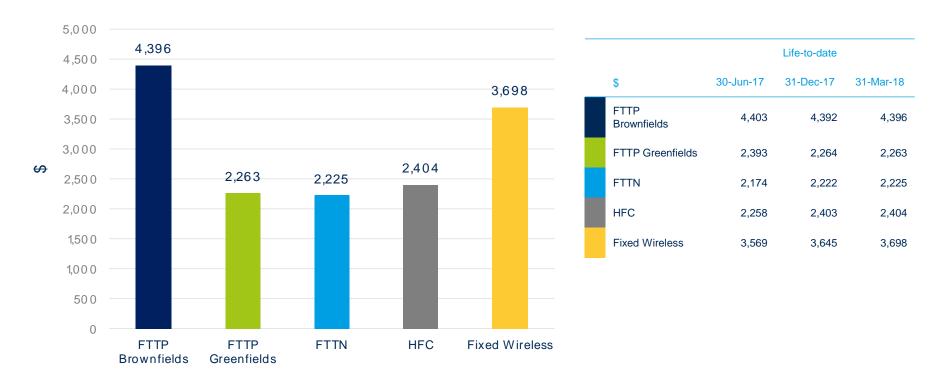

This resulted in approximately 700,000 premises being rolled back from their ready to connect status during the quarter ended 31 December 2017.

## **Capital expenditure**



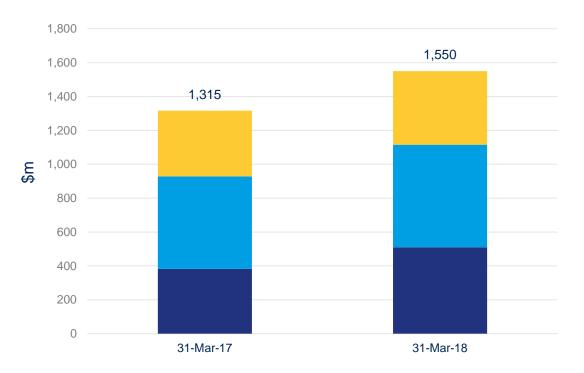

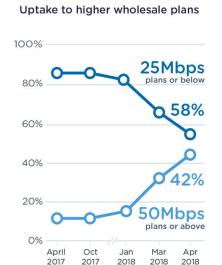

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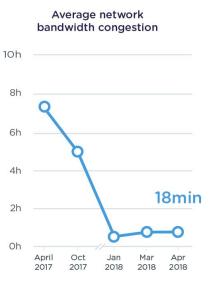
